PRESCHOOL

From late August through May our Preschool provides a variety of options. All classes enjoy a low teacher-child ratio.

Each day a variety of activities are offered including: teacher-directed circle and small groups, individual choice time, snack, large motor and playground time. Children experience a curriculum filled with activities that encourage the development of age appropriate learning objectives. We offer additional programming in the form of:

- Extended days called lunch bunch or brunch bunch. Children enjoy additional social time with friends, art and literature activities and a lunch meal (children bring their lunches). Children are required to rest for a short time
- Enrichment classes that offer an additional class time. This includes curriculum that is geared to the age level learning objectives, however, there is a strong emphasis on science, cooking, art, and drama.
- Summer Camp. This is scheduled over 5 weeks in June and July. Information about this program is available in March.

DISCOVERY DAYS

This program offers a safe, loving environment for our youngest children to acclimate to a program away from his or her parents. Classes run from late August through May. We have an ease-in schedule at the beginning of the school year to help children adjust in the most stress-free way.

Children will experience a curriculum that encourages independence, socialization, skill growth, language and spirituality.

A morning snack is provided. Children enrolled in a long day bring a lunch from home and have a nap time.

The curriculum is set up as a one day a week program, however children may attend two days if there is availability.
